MISSION

Point Man of Newburgh is a local nonprofit 501(c)(3), faith-based organization. We are affiliated with Point Man International Ministries. Point Man is comprised of local Veterans, their family members, and those passionate about our mission and vision.



Our mission is to provide safe refuge for tri-state area Veterans and their family members where they can give and receive support in the form of comradery, mentoring, spiritual healing, and financial assistance.

Our vision is that our Veterans and their family members make the transition to civilian life without judgement, regardless of age, gender, race, or life circumstances and they find faith through servant leadership and service to others.

SMALL FOCUS GROUPS

GROUP 1: INTRODUCTION

Introduction to Point Man and Home Front gives new attendees an orientation and brief history of our ministry.

GROUP 2: LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Leadership Development assess the strengths and interests of the individual and helps plug them into a particular area or project where they will be most comfortable.

GROUP 3: REACTION FORCE ALPHA

Reaction Force Alpha will support and address individual's needs and act as an organized team supporting events and functions. Meetings will have prepared lessons. However, they may go off topic to meet the needs of these men and women. Veterans struggling with their faith will find a sense of camaraderie as the group provides a bridge to a relationship with Christ.

GROUP 4: HOME FRONT

The **Home Front** group is designed to support the spouses and families of Veterans.

GROUP 5: WOMEN VETERANS

The Women Veterans group is designed for additional support and resources for our local female Veteran community.

GROUP 5: SMALL GROUP SUPPORT TEAMS

Small Group Support Teams are Bible study classes designed to engage and provide consistent contact with attendees who are sure in their faith and desire to participate in regular faith building.

Reboot: Active support and small group interaction to help Veterans and their families transition successfully from combat deployments to civilian life.

Home Front: Providing an understanding ear and caring heart that only those left behind at home can understand.

Meet & Greet: Point Man promotion of awareness of our outreach to members of our military community through visits to our local Veterans Healthcare Center.
